- The showcaller had several issues with the actual program and had to delay the entry of participants to the rooms. This create big emotional and safety pressure on the access control marshalls
- In some rooms the participants were not informed to collect the interpretation receiver. Large crowds had to rush to collection counters when the session started to collect their devices
